Pursuant to our earlier order, the Board has filed the report of inspection of the respondent no.2-Hospital made by its Senior Environmental Scientist Dr.D. K. Behera, and the Environmental Scientist Dr.S.P. Samantray.

In the conclusion and recommendations recorded in the aforesaid inspection report, it is stated that the Hospital authorities are required to take action for proper segregation of bio-medical wastes and mutilation of plastic wastes like catheters, tubings at the source of generation and sewage treatment plant should be made operative. Copy of the aforesaid report is served on the representative of the respondent-Hospital as well as learned counsel for the appellant.

The representative of the Hospital prays for some time to comply with the conclusions and recommendation as aforesaid. Put up this appeal on 17.4.2010 by which time the conclusions and recommendation shall be complied with by the Hospital authorities.
