

APPEAL NO. 1W OF 2010

In terms of the direction contained in our order dated 19.6.2010, learned Law Officer of the respondent-Board along with a memo. files compliance report regarding enforcement of the guidelines of the C.P.C.B. uniformly while giving consent to the rice mills and Chuda mills operating in the State in terms of our orders dated 10.5.2010 and 19.6.2010. Let the same be kept on record.

2. Shri B. C. Sarangi, Advocate, states that he has instruction to appear for the appellant and to that effect he files Vakalatanama as well as a petition seeking modification of the order passed by this Authority on 10.5.2010.

Copy of the petition has already been served on the learned Law Officer of the respondent-Board.

Shri Sarangi submits that the appellant has filed an application before the Regional Officer of the Board at Sambalpur seeking conversion of the production process of the appellant unit from par-boiled rice to raw rice for which consent fee has already been deposited.

Let the respondent-Board take a decision on the aforesaid petition of the appellant by 04.9.2010. In the event the Board decides to grant consent in favour of the appellant for conversion to manufacture raw rice, the impugned closure notice shall be reviewed/withdrawn and the appellant unit shall be permitted to avail power supply for running such raw rice unit.

Shri Sarangi further submits that for converting the present unit to raw rice unit, the appellant has to dismantle the entire par-boiled rice manufacturing unit for which power supply is required and unless power supply is allowed for the purpose, the dismantle cannot be done. It is open to the respondent-Board to make an enquiry into the above fact through its Regional Officer and if so required, the Board may allow the appellant to take power supply for the aforesaid purpose only and the dismantling process shall be done under the strict supervision of the Regional Officer.

The petition filed by the appellant is accordingly disposed of.
